# **Peterborough New Horizons Bands (PNHB)**

### PETERBOROUGH NEW HORIZONS BANDS ENSEMBLE GUIDELINES

### **Ensemble Formation**

- Find a small group of musicians with a common interest, all of whom are PNHB members.
- Request approval for formation of the Ensemble from the PNHB Board.
- Elect a Leadership Committee (including as a minimum a Treasurer). (The conductor should not be on the Leadership Committee.)
- □ Choose a conductor and complete a contract for conducting services. (A contract template is available.) (Note: A conductor may not always be needed, as in the case of a duet, etc.)

## **Leadership Committee**

- Arrange for rehearsal space. Negotiate a rental rate and advise the PNHB Treasurer. Advise the renter of any changes in the rehearsal schedule.
- Decide on the amount of membership dues.
- Arrange any performances. Forward a list of Ensemble Members to the Secretary of the PNHB Board effective as of October 30 each year. A template for reporting is available.
- Notify the PNHB Treasurer should a venue at which you will be playing require a Certificate of Insurance.
- Notify the PNHB Chair's delegate of any performances for which a SOCAN licence is required. The Chair's delegate will complete the required form and arrange for submission of any fee on behalf of the Ensemble.
- Maintain a listing of assets (including music, instruments, etc. purchased using Ensemble funds).

### **Ensemble Treasurer**

- Receive membership dues. (Payment by cheque, rather than cash, should be encouraged.) Once all dues for the term have been collected, submit them to PNHB Membership Dues Secretary for deposit at the Credit Union.
- Receive any invoices (for example, conductor's fees, rental fees, etc.). Approve the invoices and forward them to the PNHB Treasurer for payment.
- Keep records of receipts and invoices, as well as the bank balance for the Ensemble. Reconcile the records to those provided periodically by the PNHB Treasurer.

*Please Note:* Personal liability and property damage insurance will be covered by PNHB.
